*Quando OU oye a las otras letras, a OU le gusta decir los mismos sonidos.*

**OU** hears (*oye a*) the letter U in BLUE. OU is happy to hear it. OU says the long U sound:

**OU** hears the letter U in MUD (*lodo*). OU is happy to hear it. OU says the short U sound:



cousin (*primo/a*)



double (*doble*)



couple (*pareja*)

**OU** hears the letter O in ROSE. OU is happy to hear it. OU says the long O sound:



shoulder (*hombro*)



doughnut (*rosquilla*)

**OU** hears (*oye a*) the short O in NOT. OU is happy to hear it. OU says the short O sound:



bought (*comprado*)



thought (*pensado*)



fought (*peleado*)

**OU** hears the OR sound in CORN (*maíz*). OU is happy to hear it. OU says the OR sound:




pour (*verter*)

**OU** hears the OW sound in HOW. OU is happy to hear it. OU says the OW sound:

**OW** hears that **OU** says many different sounds. OW says "I am happy to say two sounds."

**OW** says "I am happy to say the HOW sound. In many words, I say the HOW sound."

**OW** says "And I am happy to say the long O sound in ROSE. In many words, I say the long O sound."

snow (*nieve*)

**OW** has two sounds: long O in YELLOW, or OW in HOW.

**OU** has many sounds: long U, short U, long O, short O, O in OR, or OW in HOW.

*No necesita memorizar los sonidos de OU. Solo recuerda que OU puede producir muchos sonidos diferentes. Cuando vea una palabra nueva que tenga OU, digala con diferentes sonidos hasta que encuentra un sonido que forme una palabra que reconoce.*
